

TRADE NOTICE

In continuation of the Trade Notice dated 24.10.2017 notifying the indexed Tariff for use of Mobile Harbour Cranes for cargo handling operations at Chennai Port, it is informed that the TAMP vide order No.TAMP/60/2017-ChPT dated 15.09.2017 have passed a separate SoR for M/s. GPSPL.

In compliance of the TAMP order, the users are advised to remit the MHCs charges as per Scale of Rates prescribed in the Clause 2 & 3 under the heading " Handling & Miscellaneous Charges and as per Section 58 of the MPT Act, 1963 which is reproduced below:

Section -58:- Time for payment of rates on goods:

"Rates in respect of goods to be landed shall be payable immediately on the landing of the goods and rates in respect of goods to be removed from the premises of a Board, or to be shipped for export, or to be transshipped, shall be payable before the goods are so removed or shipped or transshipped."

Therefore, Port users whose cargoes are to be moved to licensed plots or intends to take delivery by road / rail immediately on landing are advised to pay the HMCs charges in advance.

In this regard, the co-operation from the Trade is highly solicited.
