This is a remainder to our letter refer above which stated that the Shipping Agents are required to submit the following particulars and documents to the **Port Fire Officer** to obtain Port Safety Permit for the Import and Export of all Classes of Hazardous cargo. Similarly, Safety Clearance for all Chemical Substance has to be obtained from the Port Fire Officer as per the provision of the Chennai Port Safety Regulations 1981, Clause 2.1 and 2.2.

Hazardous Goods will cover all substances mentioned in the International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code classified into 9 Classes and any other Substance which the **Deputy Conservator / Safety Officer** may deem fit to be included as hazardous cargo.

I - Documents and particulars to be submitted to obtain permission for the Import of Hazardous Cargo

The following Documents and particulars are to be filed through the Shipping Agent:

Documents:

1. Bill of lading.
2. Invoice & Packing list.
3. Material Safety Data Sheet from the manufacturer of the Hazardous product.

- a. Proper shipping name and correct Technical name.
- b. The IMDG Class/Division of the goods.
- c. U.N. No.
- d. Quantity - Number and type of packages.

II - Documents and particulars to be submitted to obtain permission for the Export of Hazardous Cargo

The following documents and particulars are to be filed through the Shipping Agent:

Documents:

- 1. Invoice.
- 2. Packing list approved by Surveyors.
- 3. Material Safety data Sheet from the manufacturer of the Hazardous product.

Particulars:

- a. Proper shipping name and correct Technical name.
- b. The IMDG Class/Division of the goods.
- c. U.N. No.
- d. Quantity - Number and type of packages.
- e. Flash Point, if any.
- f. Gross Weight.
- g. Net Weight.
- h. Container No.
- i. EMS No.
- j. MFAG No.

The Shipping Agents are obtaining Port Safety Permit for Export Hazardous Cargo from the Port Fire Officer, but not for Import Hazardous Cargo.

Therefore, it is requested that both the Container Terminals may strictly allow to land or load the hazardous cargo containers based on the Port Safety Permit issued by the Port Fire Officer to the concerned Agent. The Customs may strictly allow delivery or entry of the hazardous cargo containers based on the Port Safety Permit issued by the Port Fire Officer to the concerned Agent.
